Handy Hints for your Santa Visit

We want Santa Cortney's visit to be very special.
Here are a few tips to help make your Santa visit merry and bright.

- Provide a cell phone number for the event point of contact.
- Have a special place for Santa to park - very close to the entrance of the event.
- Have someone waiting outside to meet Santa - to show him the way and to load toys into his sack if needed.
- Plan it so Santa can make a ``Grand Entrance`` - Have everyone participating in a common task, such as singing jingle bells.
- Place Santa's Chair so it has a great holiday background for photos - Leave room behind for group photos.
- Keep the children together and occupied to give Santa a few minutes for his departure.
- If there is a donation or payment, place in a Christmas Card so you don't have to hand Santa a check or cash and risk a child witnessing the transaction.
- If this is a lunch party normally we arrive after everyone has eaten.
- If there is something you want Santa to say specifically, please send script ahead of time.

Santa's Agenda:

- Santa Grand entrance – With a big HO HO HO and bells ringing.
- Santa will mingle with Children and Guests and pass out candy canes – typically someone from your group can be Santa's helper to accompany with gifts and introductions ect.
- Photo opportunity either individually or multiple group shoot.
- Distribute gifts.
- Santa departs.

The visits, depending on pictures, take anywhere from 30 to 45 minutes.
